Journals will be different in the Spring semester.

You are responsible for your assigned journal entries as well as choosing the topics from those given. You must have all entries completed and turned in on the assigned day. There will not be random journal checks now as it is time to

work on mastering your writing skills.

**AT NO TIME WILL LATE JOURNALS BE
ACCEPTED!**

Be sure to check each book title as to what are your assigned journals for that particular unit of study.

Quotes are for you to find, copy correctly in your journals, and respond to appropriately. Be sure to check your given journal assignment to determine exactly how many quotes you are to include in each particular journal section.

This is completely your responsibility!

GRADING:

- A 5 points 3/4ths of a page or more
- B 4 points 2/3rds of a page
- C 3 points 1/2 of a page
- F 2 points 1/3rd of a page or less
- No make-up journals (absent/missing entries = 0 points)
 - All entries must be thoroughly written with no "text-writing" or symbols. There will be point deductions for lack of punctuation/capitalization/attention to writing/illegibility.
- Students must write silently for the 10 minute block allotted for in-class writing. If needed, the topic writing may be completed at home.
- One point will be deducted if a student is off-task, disruptive, or "finished early."
